



Homework Policy

At Georgetown Primary School we use the methodology of 'Flipped Learning' for homework. We use Google Classroom within Hwb as a platform to share homework with learners. Learners will be given a topic/theme or area of learning to explore at home. This will be based around what will be introduced to the learners the week that follows. This will be done through text, images or video. At school the

learners will review the homework and share their understanding once the homework has been completed. Homework will be live on Google Classroom at 3.00pm each Friday and will need to be accessed by the learner by 8.30am each Monday. Learners without access to devices at home will be given access during school time.

Class teachers will review responses to homework to look at understanding and identify any misconceptions before exploring the aspect of learning further.

Weekly **Spellings**, **daily reading**, **times table practice** and **mathletics** are also home learning experiences that should be accessed at home.
